BELLINI BAR

Giuseppe Cipriani, owner of Harry's Bar in Venice, created this celebrated wine cocktail around 1934. A favourite of Ernest Hemmingway, Sinclair Lewis, Orson Welles and thousands of visitors to Venice ever since. The original was simply chilled extra dry sparkling Prosecco poured over fresh white peach puree, and is utterly divine.
